Commemoration of our Parishes' Knutsford & District War Memorial

Knutsford & District War Memorial was first opened on **02 August 1922**. Built, following **The Great War**, by determined efforts of all classes of residents of the grieving community of 18 Parishes in and around Knutsford. Land was donated 'only for that purpose', by Cuthbert Leicester Warren of Tabley, in 1919. It was initially agreed that the War Memorial should not only be a place of remembrance of the war dead, but should also serve the useful purpose of aiding the living. Remembrance Ceremonies have always taken place there, including 2021. By agreement, noted local architect, Sir Percy Scott Worthington of Mobberley, designed it as 'a small Cottage Hospital'.

The Parishes are: Knutsford, Mobberley, Pickmere, Mere, Tatton, Toft, High Legh, Tabley Superior, Tabley Inferior, Marthall, Ollerton, Over Peover, Lower Peover, Allstock, Nether Peover, Peover Inferior and Plumley. Over decades and generations local residents, have financially and physically supported our War Memorial, whether through the original landowning Trustees, or later the NHS, or latterly, British Red Cross,.

In spite of all efforts to have our still used War Memorial returned to local residents, under a Community Trust, it is currently under imminent threat of demolition, being sold by British Red Cross for that purpose, in spite of its promises in writing (1994) to 'safeguard'.

02 August 2022 will be a celebration of the **Centenary**, of the enormous effort of this community, over the last century, in providing and financially supporting our fine and useful War Memorial. Plans are being suggested, for the whole Community to bring a picnic, to Knutsford & District War Memorial, at 6pm on Tuesday, 02 August 2022. We will need bunting. To join in the Commemoration, there will be other events, such as a Knutsford Library display, running from 11 July – 13 August 2022, of the fine history of this War Memorial. There will also be an event at the library, which will bring everyone up to date with the history, in an entertaining manner. Date still to be finalised. We have a Facebook page. Please join it.

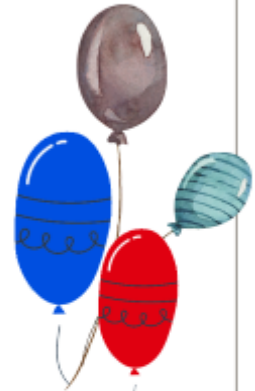
